PAX LODGE LONG-TERM RESIDENT APPLICATION FORM

Long-term accommodation is available for young women, who are members of WAGGGS, living in London for the first time. These rooms are available for 3-9 months. Accommodation is in a furnished single room with a Captain style bunk bed (raised, with a desk and shelves underneath), a table, chair, wash basin and bedside light. Bed linen is provided. Showers and toilets are shared with other long-term residents.

The cost of bed and breakfast is £ 15.58 per night for students and £21.24 for people who are working in London. (Please note that the first month you will have to pay vat on top of the prices above.)

You may also have lunches and dinners with staff and guests if ordered in advance.

Pax Lodge is a non-smoking facility.

Long-term residents are encouraged to participate whenever possible in programmes and activities offered at Pax Lodge and to take an active part with the staff in helping guests to feel at home and enjoy their stay.

Staying at Pax Lodge for an extended period of time will be a unique and memorable experience offering the opportunity to live the Girl Guide/ Girl Scout Law with sister Guides and Scouts from around the World.
